

Insect Festival Attendance Rules

1. **Teacher/Chaperone Supervision:** All children must be accompanied by a teacher/chaperone or designated adult caregiver throughout the duration of the event.
2. **Behavior Expectations:** Children are expected to follow all instructions from event organizers and staff. Disruptive or inappropriate behavior will not be tolerated.
3. **Respectful Interaction:** Children are expected to treat other participants, event staff, and property with respect and kindness.
